15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 "Rollback" means a vehicle that is designed with a ramp on wheels and a hydraulic
- 20 lift with a capacity to haul or tow an additional vehicle.

- 22 (b) (1) For purposes of this section, the length of a vehicle includes its front and
- 23 rear bumpers and any part of its load that extends beyond the vehicle, but is exclusive of
- 24 nonload bearing safety and energy conservation devices, such as marker lamps, steps and
- 25 handholds for entry and egress, front-mounted refrigeration units, and front-mounted air
- 26 compressors.
- 27 (d) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a bus, a single unit truck, or
- 28 a Class M motor home may not be over 40 feet long.

- 1 (2) A ROLLBACK VEHICLE MAY NOT BE OVER 45 FEET LONG.
- 2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3 October 1, 1996.
