2 Mass Transit Administration - Light Rail Transit - Purchase of Interconnecting Cars

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that each light rail transit vehicle ordered by the Mass
- 4 Transit Administration after a certain date be of the type that connects with other
- 5 light rail vehicles in a manner that allows security to move freely and safely between
- 6 the vehicles while the light rail train is in motion; providing for the effective date of
- 7 this Act; and generally relating to the purchase of light rail transit vehicles.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) Purchases on behalf of the Administration of rolling stock and other property
- 18 peculiar to the operation of transit facilities or railroad facilities are not subject to law
- 19 governing procurement by the Department of General Services.
- 20 (b) The selection of long-lead equipment items for purposes of a light rail transit
- 21 system shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the State procurement laws and
- 22 regulations and shall use either a competitive sealed bid or competitive sealed proposal
- 23 method of procurement.
- 24 (C) EACH LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT VEHICLE ORDERED BY THE ADMINISTRATION
- 25 AFTER JANUARY 1, 1997 THAT IS INTENDED TO CARRY PASSENGERS SHALL BE OF
- 26 THE TYPE THAT CONNECTS WITH OTHER LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES IN A MANNER THAT
- 27 ALLOWS SECURITY TO MOVE FREELY AND SAFELY BETWEEN VEHICLES WHILE THE
- 28 LIGHT RAIL TRAIN IS IN MOTION.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 July 1, 1996.
