- 20 (a) Every person is required to obtain a permit from the Department to
- 21 appropriate or use or begin to construct any plant, building, or structure which may
- 22 appropriate or use any waters of the State, whether surface water or groundwater. The
- 23 permit is obtained upon written application to the Department. The applicant shall
- 24 provide the Department with satisfactory proof that the proposed withdrawal of water
- 25 will not jeopardize the State's natural resources.
- 26 (b) This section does not apply to use of water for:
- 27 (1) Domestic purposes other than for heating and cooling; [or]
- 28 (2) Agricultural purposes, if the average annual water use is less than 10,000
- 29 gallons per day, except as provided in subsection (c)(2) of this section; OR
