- 7 providing for the Department of Business and Economic Development toperform
- 8 the duties formerly assigned to the Office of Business Development and Resources;
- 9 changing the name of the Office of International Trade within the Department, to
- 10 the Office of International Business; changing the name of the Division of Tourism
- 11 and Promotion within the Department, to the Division of Tourism, Film, and the
- 12 Arts; and generally relating to the operation of the Department of Business and

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

8 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development

(a) The Commission shall have the general purpose of establishing economic
development policy in the State and overseeing the Department's efforts attract,
retain, and support the creation of businesses and jobs.

14 (b) The Commission shall:

15 (1) Develop and update a strategic plan for economic development in the16 State;

17 (2) Recommend to the Governor program and spending priorities necessary18 to implement the strategic plan;

(3) [Review the Department's budget prior to its submission to the20 Governor and General Assembly for approval;

21 (4) Advise the Secretary periodically on the allocation of economic 22 development resources in the Department, particularly with regard to regional allocation 22 a b line view.

24 (5)] Approve Department regulations pertaining to financing programs prior25 to their adoption;

26 [(6)] (4) Review the allocation of financing incentives;

[(7)] (5) Participate in marketing the State and encouraging new businessesto locate in Maryland;

 30 economic development programs and financial incentives to business;

[(9)] (7) Carry out any other economic development activities at the requestof the Governor; and

[(10)] (8) Exercise those powers granted to the Commission by this title or34 any other provision of law.

| 3 There is an Office of Business Development and Resources within the4 Department.] |
| 5 [3-202.] 3-201. |
| 6 The [Office] DEPARTMENT shall: |
| (1) Investigate and assemble information pertinent to the economic development, industrial opportunities and economic resources of the State, including raw materials, power and water resources, transportation facilities, markets, labor, banking and financing facilities, industrial sites and other fields of research; |
| (2) Encourage location and development of new business enterprises in the State and the retention and expansion of present enterprises in coordination with local governing bodies and local economic development agencies; |
| 14 (3) [Coordinate its activities with those of the Division of Tourism and15 Promotion in the promotion of tourism in the State; |
| 16 (4)] Encourage formation of local and sectional development committees 17 and cooperate with local civic groups and other local, State and federal development 18 agencies; |

3 [(14)] (13) Utilize the resources of the State's community colleges, as the 4 [Office] DEPARTMENT deems appropriate, to provide assistance in the delivery of 5 services; and

6 [(15)] (14) Administer those programs assigned to the [Office]7 DEPARTMENT by law or designated by the Secretary.

9 The Secretary, with the approval of the Governor, shall appoint a Director of the 10 Office. The Director shall hold office at the Secretary's pleasure and may be removed by 11 the Secretary, with the approval of the Governor. Any such removal by the Secretary is 12 final and is not subject to any appeal. The Director shall be selected because of known 13 experience and interest in the development of natural resources and industrial and 14 business opportunities. The Director shall operate this Office under the direction of the 15 Secretary in accordance with the provisions of the law relating to establishment of the 16 Department.]

In the performance of duties, the Director, subject to the approval of the Secretary or the Secretary's designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to makeand enter into contracts, and to assume such other functions as are necessary to carryout the provisions of this subtitle that are not inconsistent with this or other acts. TheDirector, subject to approval of the Secretary, may make and enter into contracts with otherboards, commissions, agencies and institutions of this State or other states, upon such terms as may be mutually agreed upon, to have such studies and research activities conducted as may be necessary and proper, and is authorized to pay the cost thereof out of funds which may be appropriated to the Office.]

(a) The [Office] DEPARTMENT shall provide support to industry-led regional
 technology councils that provide assistance to private enterprises attempting to establish
 or expand manufacturing and technology-based businesses.

31 (b) The [Office] DEPARTMENT in its discretion, shall determine:

(1) Which entity will best serve as the regional technology council for aparticular region;

The [Office] DEPARTMENT shall have access to all records, data, information and 6 statistics of such other boards, commissions, agencies and institutionsexcept records or 7 information required by law to be confidential and secret.

(a) There is an Office of International [Trade] BUSINESS within the Department
to promote the development of international [trade] BUSINESS activities and
opportunities for the citizens of this State.

13 3-302.

14 The Office of International [Trade] BUSINESS shall report not less than twice 15 annually to the Maryland Economic Development Commission on the status of the State's 16 international activities.

17 Title 4. Division of Tourism [and Promotion], FILM, AND THE ARTS.

18 4-101.

19 There is a Division of Tourism [and Promotion], FILM, AND THE ARTS within the 20 Department.

21 4-102.

(a) (1) With the approval of the Governor, the Secretary shall appoint aDirector of the Division of Tourism [and Promotion], FILM, AND THE ARTS.

24 (2) The Director shall hold office at the Secretary's pleasure.

(3) With the approval of the Governor, the Director may be removed by theSecretary.

(4) Any such removal by the Secretary is final and is not subject to anyappeal.

(b) The Director shall be selected because of known experience and interest in30 tourism [and promotion], FILM, AND THE ARTS.

(c) The Director shall operate this Division under the direction of the Secretaryin accordance with the provisions of law.

33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 34 July 1, 1996.
