- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Education
- 15 8-415.
- 16 (H) A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR COMPETENT STUDENT AT LEAST 18 YEARS
- 17 OLD MAY NOT BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT OR PAYMENT ON THEIR BEHALF
- 18 FOR ANY EXPENSES, TUITION, ATTORNEY'S FEES, COSTS, OR SERVICES THAT WERE
- 19 INCURRED MORE THAN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE FILING OF A DUE PROCESS HEARING
- 20 REQUEST UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1996.
