A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Students with Disabilities - Reimbursement and Payment Limitations**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the reimbursement or payment to a parent, guardian, or
4 competent student of a certain age for expenses, tuition, attorney's fees, costs, or
5 services that were incurred more than a specified period prior to the filing of a
6 certain hearing request.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 8-415.

16 (H) A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR COMPETENT STUDENT AT LEAST 18 YEARS
17 OLD MAY NOT BE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT OR PAYMENT ON THEIR BEHALF
18 FOR ANY EXPENSES, TUITION, ATTORNEY'S FEES, COSTS, OR SERVICES THAT WERE
19 INCURRED MORE THAN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE FILING OF A DUE PROCESS HEARING
20 REQUEST UNDER THIS SECTION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 1996.
