13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

16 25-201.

17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies only

18 to:

19 (1) correctional officers serving in any of the first six job classifications;

20 [and]

21 (2) security attendants at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center;

- 22 (3) CORRECTIONAL DIETARY OFFICERS; AND
- 23 (4) CORRECTIONAL MAINTENANCE OFFICERS.

- 25 (a) A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:
- 26 (1) on or before the date of retirement, the member has at least 20 years of 27 eligibility service;
