2 **Education - School Buses - Charging of Fees Prohibited**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the charging of a fee for transporting public school
4 students to and from school.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - Education**

13 7-601.

14 (b) (1) At its own expense, a county governing body may provide transportation
15 for public school students in addition to the transportation provided by the State.

16 (2) A FEE MAY NOT BE CHARGED FOR TRANSPORTING PUBLIC SCHOOL
17 STUDENTS TO AND FROM SCHOOL.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 July 1, 1996.
