12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 (n) (1) The Sheriff of Harford County shall not have employment outside of 17 that position, and shall receive a salary of:

- 18 (i) \$52,000 in 1991;
- 19 (ii) \$55,000 in 1992;
- 20 (iii) \$58,000 in 1993; [and]
- 21 (iv) \$60,000 in 1994 [and thereafter.]; AND

2 3	(2) The Sheriff shall appoint the number of deputies at the compensation provided in the county budget.
