- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 23 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, every new application for a
- 24 license shall be made to the Board of License Commissioners upon forms prescribed by
- 25 the Comptroller and sworn to by the applicant. Every application for a license shall
- 26 contain the following statements:
- 27 (13) (i) 2. The respective boards shall destroy the records obtained
- 28 under subparagraphs (ii), (iv), (v), (vi), [and] (vii), AND (VIII) of this paragraph upon
- 29 completion of its necessary use of the records;
- 30 (VIII) IN HARFORD COUNTY:

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1	1. THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD SHALL:
4	A. OBTAIN CRIMINAL RECORDS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE APPLICANTS FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;

- 6 B. REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES 7 LICENSES IN THE COUNTY TO BE FINGERPRINTED; AND
- 8 C. FORWARD THE FINGERPRINTS THROUGH THE CRIMINAL 9 JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 10 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE
- $11\,$ FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY
- 12 RECORDS CHECK; AND
- 13 2. APPLICANTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL MAY NOT BE 14 SUBJECT TO THESE PROVISIONS.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 1996.
