CHAPTER \_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2           **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
3           **(Salaries of Liquor Control Board)**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation paid the chairman and members of the  
5 Harford County Liquor Control Board; providing that this Act does not apply to the  
6 salary or compensation of the incumbent chairman and members of the Board; and  
7 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 15-201(h)(2)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15           **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 15-201.

17           (h) Members of the several boards shall receive compensation as follows:

18                   (2) In Harford County:

19                           (i) The Chairman of the Board shall receive an annual compensation  
20 of [\$3,000] \$4,500;

21                           (ii) Each member of the Board shall receive an annual compensation  
22 of [\$2,700] \$4,000; and

1 (iii) The Chairman and each member of the Board shall receive any  
2 additional compensation that the County Council deems appropriate.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,  
4 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or  
5 apply to the salary or compensation of the Chairman and members of the Harford County  
6 Liquor Control Board in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this  
7 Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Chairman and members of the Harford  
8 County Liquor Control Board shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term  
9 of office.

10 SECTION ~~2.~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 October 1, 1996.
