A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2           **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
3           **(Liquor Control Board)**

4 FOR the purpose of extending in Harford County the immunity from suits against the  
5       Liquor Control Board for damages and subjecting them only to suit only for the  
6       enforcement of contracts; and generally relating to the Liquor Control Board in  
7       Harford County.

8 BY adding to

9       Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
10       Section 5-318.1  
11       Annotated Code of Maryland  
12       (1995 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

13       SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15       **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 5-318.1.

17       THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FOR HARFORD COUNTY IS:

18           (1) IMMUNE FROM ALL SUITS FOR DAMAGES; AND

19           (2) SUBJECT TO SUIT ONLY FOR ENFORCEMENT OF CONTRACTS MADE  
20 BY THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FOR THE COUNTY.

21       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
22 October 1, 1996.
