- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- (d) (1) [No] A licensee, proprietor, or operator of any establishment
- 16 dispensing alcoholic beverages [shall] MAY NOT permit the consumption or possession
- 17 of any alcoholic beverages by a person under the age of twenty-one years [upon said] ON
- 18 THE premises no matter by whom [such] THE alcoholic beverages [shall have been]
- 19 WERE purchased or from whom THEY WERE obtained.
- 20 (2) A violation of this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
- 21 not more than [\$50] \$500 in addition to any other penalties provided under this article.
