SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-909.
(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CECIL COUNTY. 8 LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD. 10 ONE TIME IN ANY CALENDAR YEAR. THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DAYS THAT MAY 11 BE AUTHORIZED IS 12 PER YEAR.

## 12 (E) (1) THE LICENSEE SHALL HAVE THE FACILITIES TO PREPARE AND

 13 DELIVER FOOD TO THE SITE OF THE CATERED EVENT.SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 1996.
