BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 4 **Article - Business Regulation** 5 [8-504. 6 Except for a permit for a home improvement to be performed by a property owner, 7 the building and permits department of a county OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION may 8 not issue a permit for a home improvement unless the permit includes the license number 9 of a licensed contractor. 10 8-504. (A) THE BUILDING AND PERMITS DEPARTMENT OF A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL 11 12 CORPORATION, OR OTHER LOCAL ISSUING AUTHORITY MAY NOT ISSUE ANY 13 PERMIT FOR HOME IMPROVEMENT UNLESS THE PERMIT APPLICATION INCLUDES A 14 NOTICE THAT: 15 (1) PROVIDES A CURRENT STATUTORY DEFINITION OF "HOME 16 IMPROVEMENT"; 17 (2) INCLUDES THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE COMMISSION; AND 18 (3) CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "EACH CONTRACTOR AND EACH SUBCONTRACTOR MUST BE LICENSED BY THE 19 20 MARYLAND HOME IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION, ANY PERSON MAY ASK THE 21 MARYLAND HOME IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION ABOUT A CONTRACTOR OR 22 SUBCONTRACTOR." 23 (B) THE BUILDING AND PERMITS DEPARTMENT OF A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL 24 CORPORATION, OR OTHER LOCAL ISSUING AUTHORITY MAY NOT ISSUE A PERMIT 25 FOR HOME IMPROVEMENT TO BE PERFORMED BY A PROPERTY OWNER UNLESS THE 26 APPLICATION INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT, SIGNED BY THE PROPERTY 27 OWNER: "I AM AN OWNER OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS PERMIT APPLICATION. 28 29 I WILL PERSONALLY PERFORM THE WORK DESCRIBED IN THE PERMIT AT THE 30 PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE PERMIT. I UNDERSTAND THAT I MAY PERSONALLY 31 COMPLETE IMPROVEMENTS ON MY HOME WITHOUT BEING A LICENSED HOME 32 IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTOR, I ALSO UNDERSTAND THAT IT IS ILLEGAL FOR AN 33 INDIVIDUAL TO ACT AS A HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTOR OR 34 SUBCONTRACTOR IN MARYLAND WITHOUT BEING LICENSED AND THAT NO CLAIMS 35 MAY BE MADE AGAINST THE HOME IMPROVEMENT GUARANTEE FUND FOR 36 DAMAGES OR LOSSES SUFFERED BY A PROPERTY OWNER WHO HIRES AN 37 UNLICENSED CONTRACTOR." (C) THE BUILDING AND PERMITS DEPARTMENT OF A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL

38 (C) THE BUILDING AND PERMITS DEPARTMENT OF A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL
39 CORPORATION, OR OTHER LOCAL ISSUING AUTHORITY MAY NOT ISSUE A PERMIT

- 1 FOR HOME IMPROVEMENT TO BE PERFORMED BY A HOME IMPROVEMENT
- 2 CONTRACTOR UNLESS:
- 3 (1) THE PERMIT INCLUDES THE LICENSE NUMBER OF A LICENSED
- 4 CONTRACTOR; AND
- 5 (2) THE APPLICATION FOR THE PERMIT CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING
- 6 STATEMENT, SIGNED BY THE PROPERTY OWNER:
- 7 "I AM AN OWNER OF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS PERMIT APPLICATION.
- 8 IUNDERSTAND THAT EACH CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR MUST BE
- 9 LICENSED BY THE HOME IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION AND THAT ANYONE MAY ASK
- 10 THE COMMISSION ABOUT A CONTRACTOR OR A SUBCONTRACTOR. I FURTHER
- 11 UNDERSTAND THAT IT IS ILLEGAL FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO ACT AS A HOME
- 12 IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR IN MARYLAND WITHOUT BEING
- 13 LICENSED AND THAT NO CLAIMS MAY BE MADE AGAINST THE HOME IMPROVEMENT
- 14 GUARANTEE FUND FOR DAMAGES OR LOSSES SUFFERED BY A PROPERTY OWNER
- 15 WHO HIRES AN UNLICENSED CONTRACTOR.
- 16 I HAVE RECEIVED FROM MY CONTRACTOR THE TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE
- 17 MARYLAND HOME IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION."
- 18 (D) A NOTICE OR STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE
- 19 CONTAINED IN A PERMIT APPLICATION OR ATTACHED TO A PERMIT APPLICATION.
- 20 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the building and permits</u>
- 21 <u>department of any municipal corporation may use all of its home improvement permit</u>
- 22 application forms that the building and permits department has in stockas of October 1,
- 23 1996 before using home improvement permit application forms that include spaces for the
- 24 license numbers required under this Act.
- 25 SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 1996.
