- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Business Regulation

- 15 (a) The Comptroller shall pay from the Special Fund an annual grant of:
- 16 (1) \$600,000 to the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board to promoteState and 17 county agricultural fairs and exhibits;
- 18 (2) \$100,000 to Prince George's County to replace money formerly received
- 19 from the admissions and amusement tax;
- 20 (3) \$40,000 to the Great Frederick Fair to support exhibition harness racing
- 21 with money for construction and maintenance of new stalls, track maintenance, and
- 22 purses; [and]
- 23 (4) \$50 to the City of Bowie for each day that the training facilities are open
- 24 at the Bowie Race Course Training Center; AND
- 25 (5) \$75,000 TO THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION
- 26 FOUNDATION, INC., TO PROMOTE AND ENHANCE STATEWIDE AGRICULTURAL
- 27 EDUCATION.
