2 Higher Education - Tuition and Fee Waivers - Members of the Maryland National Guard

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain state institutions of higher education, including 4 community colleges, to waive one-half of the tuition charged for certain courses for 5 certain members of the Maryland National Guard under certain circumstances; requiring that members of the Maryland National Guard be certified as eligible by 6 the Maryland Adjutant General; requiring the repayment of a tuition waiver under 7 8 certain circumstances; authorizing the presidents of certain institutions of higher 9 education, including community colleges, to waive up to 100% of tuition for certain 10 courses and fees for certain members of the Maryland National Guard; defining 11 certain terms; and generally relating to tuition waivers for membersof the Maryland 12 National Guard.
