11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) The primary elections by the political parties for candidates for State offices
- 16 and central committee shall be held throughout this State on the secondTuesday after
- 17 the first Monday in September. The primary elections by the political parties in each year
- 18 in which a national convention is held for the nomination of candidates for President and
- 19 Vice-President shall be held throughout this State on the [first Tuesday in March]
- 20 SECOND TUESDAY IN MAY. A special primary election to fill a vacancy in the office of
- 21 Representative in Congress shall be held on such date as the Governor shall specify
- 22 pursuant to § 22-1(b) of this article.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 1996.
