- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Any person selected by any board as a judge, as hereinbefore in thisarticle
- 15 provided, who shall fail or refuse to serve as such judge, or who having been notified by
- 16 said board to appear for examination of his qualifications for judge, shall fail or refuse so
- 17 to appear for examination, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and not
- 18 more than three hundred dollars (\$300), unless it shall appear that he was not qualified
- 19 for such service or appearance for such examination by reason of ill health, infirmity or
- 20 old age.]
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1996.
