10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 Article 33 - Election Code

13 [24-4.

Any person selected by any board as a judge, as hereinbefore in thisarticle provided, who shall fail or refuse to serve as such judge, or who having been notified by said board to appear for examination of his qualifications for judge, shall fail or refuse so to appear for examination, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and not more than three hundred dollars (\$300), unless it shall appear that he was not qualified for such service or appearance for such examination by reason of ill health, infirmity or old age.]
