## A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN	ACT	concerning

## 2 Boxers and Kick Boxers - Blood Tests

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring boxers and kick boxers to submit to a blood test for human
- 4 immunodeficiency virus and Hepatitis B at certain times; prohibiting aboxer or kick
- 5 boxer who has tested positive for human immunodeficiency virus or Hepatitis B to
- 6 enter a ring; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to
- 7 requiring certain blood tests for boxers and kick boxers.
- 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 Section 4-304 and 4-315
- 11 Annotated Code of Maryland

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article - Business Regulation

16 4-304.

- 17 (a) A licensee shall be examined by a licensed physician who is chosen by the
- 18 Commission and who specializes in neurology or neurosurgery prior to the licensee's first
- 19 appearance as a contestant in a kick boxing or boxing contest followingthe issuance or
- 20 renewal of a license.
- 21 (b) A LICENSEE SHALL SUBMIT TO A BLOOD TEST FOR HUMAN
- 22 IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) AND HEPATITIS B BY A LICENSED LABORATORY
- 23 CHOSEN BY THE COMMISSION PRIOR TO THE LICENSEE'S FIRST APPEARANCE AS A
- 24 CONTESTANT IN A KICK BOXING OR BOXING CONTEST FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE
- 25 OR RENEWAL OF A LICENSE AND EVERY 3 MONTHS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OR
- 26 RENEWAL OF A LICENSE.
- 27 (C) The Commission shall pay the cost of the neurological examination AND
- 28 BLOOD TESTS required under this section from license fees collected under this subtitle.

- 30 (a) A boxer or kick boxer shall be allowed to enter the ring only [if ] IF:

1	(1) a physician approved by the Commission declares the boxer or kick
2	boxer to be physically fit: AND

- 3 (2) THE BOXER OR KICK BOXER HAS NOT TESTED POSITIVE FOR
- 4 HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS OR HEPATITIS B ON THE MOST RECENT BLOOD
- 5 TEST REQUIRED BY § 4-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 6 (b) Each boxer or kick boxer in a contest shall submit to a chemicaltest of the
- 7 urine of the boxer or kick boxer to detect the presence of a controlleddangerous
- 8 substance defined under Article 27, § 277 of the Code or other substance that the
- 9 Commission prohibits by regulation.
- 10 (c) Each boxer or kick boxer in a contest shall wear gloves that weigh at least 5 11 ounces.
- 12 (d) The Commission shall set the length in rounds of each boxing andkick boxing 13 contest.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 15 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has
- 16 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
- 17 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 18 enacted.
