## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Special Policemen - Termination or Suspension

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the commission of a special policemanmay be
- 4 suspended; authorizing the Governor to delegate to the Secretary of State or the
- 5 Assistant Secretary of State the authority to revoke or suspend the commission of a
- 6 special policeman; and generally relating to special policemen.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 14 Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

15 4-913.

- 16 (A) The commissions granted under this subtitle shall cease OR BE SUSPENDED
- 17 upon the filing of a notice in writing by the State, agency, college, school system, or
- 18 business which requested the appointment, stating that the policeman [is no longer
- 19 required and] has been relieved of OR SUSPENDED FROM his duties. The Governor,
- 20 upon recommendation by the Secretary of the State Police, or on the Governor's own
- 21 motion if the Governor finds it in the best interest of the State, may terminate OR
- 22 SUSPEND any commission granted under this subtitle. The termination OR SUSPENSION
- 23 shall be noted in the official records of the Governor and shall not beeffective until five
- 24 days after notice is sent to the requesting State, agency, school, or business and also to the
- 25 person whose commission has been revoked OR SUSPENDED. If that person thereafter,
- 26 knowing of the revocation OR SUSPENSION or having in any manner received notice
- 27 thereof, exercises or attempts to exercise any of the powers granted under this subtitle,
- 28 that person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor; and upon conviction be fined not more than
- 29 \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both. The filing and mailing of
- 30 notice as indicated above shall raise a presumption that the person knew of the revocation
- 31 OR SUSPENSION.

- 1 (B) THE GOVERNOR MAY DELEGATE THE POWER TO TERMINATE OR
- 2 SUSPEND A COMMISSION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE, THE
- 3 ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE, OR BOTH.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1996.
