- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16 6-301.

- 17 (u) (4) There is a fraternal or sororal license. The licensee shall:
- 18 (ii) Have been in existence and operating in the county for a period of
- 19 not less than [5 years] 1 YEAR prior to the time of making application for the license;
- 20 (5) There is a veterans' license. The licensee shall:
- 21 (ii) Have held a charter from a national veterans' organization for a
- 22 period of not less than [5 years] 1 YEAR prior to the time of application for licensing;
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 24 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has
- 25 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
- 26 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 27 enacted.
