- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Sheriff of Frederick County to appoint as special
- 4 deputy sheriffs certain investigators with the Office of the Frederick County State's
- 5 Attorney; and making this Act an emergency measure.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 14 2-309.
- 15 (l) (4) (i) The Sheriff of Frederick County may appoint special deputy
- 16 sheriffs who are:
- 17 1. A. Members of the police force of a Frederick County
- 18 municipality;
- 19 [2.] B. Selected by the chief of police of the municipality; and
- 20 [3.] C. Verified by the chief of police of the municipality as
- 21 having achieved at least the minimum level of training for police duties in a municipality
- 22 as designated by the Maryland Police Training Commission; OR
- 23 2. A. INVESTIGATORS WITH THE OFFICE OF THE STATE'S
- 24 ATTORNEY OF FREDERICK COUNTY WHO ARE AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE'S
- 25 ATTORNEY; AND
- 26 B. VERIFIED BY THE STATE'S ATTORNEY AS HAVING
- 27 ACHIEVED AT LEAST THE MINIMUM LEVEL OF TRAINING FOR POLICE DUTIES IN A

- 1 MUNICIPALITY, COUNTY, OR STATE, AS DESIGNATED BY THE MARYLAND POLICE 2 TRAINING COMMISSION.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 4 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has
- 5 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
- 6 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 7 enacted.
