BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 18 Article - Education 19 5-108.1.

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PERFORMANCE AUDIT" MEANS AN ASSESSMENT OF AN
- 21 ENTITY'S OR PROGRAM'S PRACTICES TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE ENTITY OR
- 22 PROGRAM IS OPERATING ECONOMICALLY AND EFFICIENTLY AND WHETHER
- 23 CORRECTIVE ACTIONS FOR IMPROVING ITS PERFORMANCE ARE APPROPRIATE.

- 1 (B) IN THE ABSENCE OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN A COUNTY GOVERNING
- 2 BODY AND A COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD. THE DEPARTMENT AT THE REOUEST OF THE
- 3 COUNTY GOVERNING BODY SHALL CONTRACT FOR A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF THE
- 4 COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM TO ADDRESS THE ISSUES RAISED IN THE
- 5 COUNTY'S REQUEST.
- 6 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE REASONABLE EFFORTS TO ENSURE
- 7 THAT A PERFORMANCE AUDIT UNDER THIS SECTION IS COMPLETED AND THE
- 8 RESULTS OF THE AUDIT ARE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN TIME TO
- $9\,$  BE CONSIDERED BY THE COUNTY BOARD IN THE PREPARATION OF ITS BUDGET FOR
- 10 THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR.
- 11 (D) THE COST OF A PERFORMANCE AUDIT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 12 SHARED EQUALLY BETWEEN THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY AND THE COUNTY
- 13 BOARD.
- 14 (E) A PERFORMANCE AUDIT <del>UNDER</del> <u>FOR WHICH THE DEPARTMENT</u>
- 15 CONTRACTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:
- 16 (1) SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY
- 17 ACCEPTED GOVERNMENT AUDITING STANDARDS; AND
- 18 (2) MAY NOT INCLUDE AN ASSESSMENT OR EVALUATION OF A COUNTY
- 19 BOARD'S EFFORTS TO MEET THE STANDARDS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOL
- 20 PERFORMANCE PROGRAM.
- 21 (F) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PREVENTS A COUNTY GOVERNING BODY AND
- 22 A COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD FROM MAKING AN AGREEMENT TO PERFORM OR
- 23 CONTRACT FOR A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF SCHOOL BOARD FUNCTIONS,
- 24 INCLUDING AN AGREEMENT INVOLVING THE SCOPE OF THE PERFORMANCE AUDIT
- 25 OR THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FUNDING OF THE PERFORMANCE AUDIT.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 July 1, 1996.
