- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 14 36A.
- 15 (a) No person, unless otherwise excepted in this section, shall carry or possess any 16 rifle, gun, knife, or deadly weapon of any kind on any public school property in this State.
- 17 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to [law]:
- 18 (1) LAW enforcement officers in the regular course of their duty[, or to any
- 19 persons];
- 20 (2) PERSONS hired by the boards of education in the counties and
- 21 Baltimore City specifically for the purpose of guarding public school property[, or to
- 22 persons];
- 23 (3) PERSONS engaged in organized shooting activity for educational
- 24 purposes; OR
- 25 (4) PERSONS WHO, WITH A WRITTEN INVITATION FROM THE SCHOOL
- 26 PRINCIPAL, DISPLAY OR ENGAGE IN HISTORICAL DEMONSTRATIONS USING
- 27 WEAPONS OR REPLICAS OF WEAPONS FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

- 1 (c) Any person who violates this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a 2 misdemeanor and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of no more than [one thousand dollars 3 (\$1,000.00),] \$1,000 or shall be sentenced to the Maryland Department of Correction for 4 a period of not more than [three (3)] 3 years. Any such person who shall be found to 5 carry a handgun in violation of this section[,] shall be sentenced as provided in § 36B of 6 this article.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 1996.
