- 13 (3) SHALL CHOOSE A LOCATION IN THE COUNTY FOR THIS FESTIVAL
- 14 WHICH IS NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE; AND
- 15 (4) SHALL ASSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE FESTIVAL IS THE
- 16 PROMOTION OF MARYLAND BEER AND WINE.
- 17 (H) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 2-301(F) AND 12-103(C) OF
- 18 THIS ARTICLE, BEER AND WINE PRODUCTS NOT AUTHORIZED FOR GENERAL
- 19 DISTRIBUTION IN MARYLAND AT THE TIME OF THE FESTIVAL MAY BE SHIPPED
- 20 DIRECTLY TO A SPECIAL FESTIVAL LICENSEE BY A LICENSED NONRESIDENT

- 22 (2) ALL INVOICES FOR PRODUCTS DELIVERED DIRECTLY TO THE

- 32 TO ACCEPT RETURNS 2 DAYS AFTER THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE SPECIAL

- 34 (I) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS
