A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Health Insurance - Diabetes Equipment, Supplies, and Training - Coverage

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and

4 health maintenance organizations provide coverage for certain diabetes equipment,

- 5 diabetes supplies, and diabetes outpatient self-management training and
- 6 educational services; requiring that certain diabetes outpatient self-management

7 training and educational services be provided through a program supervised by

8 certain diabetes educators; and generally relating to the provision of coverage for

- 9 certain diabetes equipment, diabetes supplies, and diabetes outpatient
- 10 self-management training and educational services.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 Article 48A - Insurance Code

24 490FF.

25 (A) ANY INSURER OR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN THAT PROVIDES

26 HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS FOR ISSUANCE OR DELIVERY IN THE

27 STATE TO ANY GROUP OR INDIVIDUAL ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS,

28 INCLUDING A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION, SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE

29 FOR ALL MEDICALLY APPROPRIATE AND NECESSARY DIABETES EQUIPMENT,

30 DIABETES SUPPLIES, AND DIABETES OUTPATIENT SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING

AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES THAT THE INSURED'S TREATING PHYSICIAN, OR A
 PHYSICIAN WHO SPECIALIZES IN THE TREATMENT OF DIABETES, CERTIFIES ARE
 NECESSARY.

4 (B) DIABETES OUTPATIENT SELF-MANAGEMENT TRAINING AND
5 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SHALL BE PROVIDED THROUGH A PROGRAM SUPERVISED
6 BY A DIABETES EDUCATOR CERTIFIED BY THE NATIONAL CERTIFICATION BOARD
7 FOR DIABETES EDUCATORS.

10 (d) (1) The provisions of Article 48A, § 58A of the Code and Article48A,11 Subtitles 9A and 11 shall apply to health maintenance organizations.

12 (2) THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 48A, § 490FF OF THE CODE SHALL13 APPLY TO HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.
