11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

14 60A.

- (a) [Without the approval of the Secretary of Agriculture, a] A person may notgive away any live animal[, equine, or bird] as:
- 17 (1) A prize for, or as an inducement to enter any contest, game, or other18 competition; or
- 19 (2) An inducement to enter a place of amusement; or
- 20 (3) As an incentive to enter into any business agreement where the offer was21 for the purpose of attracting trade.
- (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guiltyof amisdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
- (c) The provisions of this section do not apply to a person or organization whogives away an animal:
- 26 (1) As an agricultural project; or

- 1 (2) For conservation purposes; or
- 2 (3) Which is intended for slaughter.
