A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes - Animals as Prizes, Inducements, or Incentives - Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing an exception to the prohibition against giving away a live
4 animal as a prize, inducement, or incentive under certain circumstances; making a
5 technical change; and generally relating to the prohibition of giving away animals.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments**

14 60A.

15 (a) [Without the approval of the Secretary of Agriculture, a] A person may not
16 give away any live animal[, equine, or bird] as:

17 (1) A prize for, or as an inducement to enter any contest, game, or other
18 competition; or

19 (2) An inducement to enter a place of amusement; or

20 (3) As an incentive to enter into any business agreement where the offer was
21 for the purpose of attracting trade.

22 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a
23 misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.

24 (c) The provisions of this section do not apply to a person or organization who
25 gives away an animal:

26 (1) As an agricultural project; or

1 (2) For conservation purposes; or

2 (3) Which is intended for slaughter.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

4 October 1, 1996.
