1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Institutions of Higher Education - Requirement for Immunizations

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each senior institution of higher education to require each
- 4 student to submit certain records of certain immunizations against certain diseases
- 5 before enrolling the student; providing certain exceptions; requiring the
- 6 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation with the Maryland
- 7 Higher Education Commission, to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms;
- 8 and generally relating to requiring records of certain immunizations before
- 9 enrolling students in senior institutions of higher education in the State.
- 10 BY adding to
- 11 Article Education
- 12 Section 11-207
- 13 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 14 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)
- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 **Article Education**
- 18 11-207.
- $19 \hspace{1.5cm} (A) \hspace{1.5cm} (1)$  IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS  $20 \hspace{1.5cm} \text{INDICATED.}$
- 21 (2) "SENIOR INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION" MEANS:
- 22 (I) A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION; OR
- 23 (II) A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT
- 24 AWARDS DEGREES AT THE BACCALAUREATE OR GRADUATE LEVEL.
- 25 (3) "STUDENT" MEANS AN UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE STUDENT
- 26 WHO IS UNDER THE AGE OF 31 YEARS AND IS ENROLLED FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME
- 27 IN A PROGRAM OR COURSE OF STUDY LEADING TO AN ACADEMIC DEGREE AT A
- 28 SENIOR INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

- 1 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, BEFORE
- 2 PERMITTING A STUDENT TO ENROLL IN THE INSTITUTION, EACH SENIOR
- 3 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL REQUIRE THE STUDENT TO SUBMIT TO
- 4 THE INSTITUTION A VALID IMMUNIZATION RECORD THAT DOCUMENTS THE
- 5 ADMINISTRATION OF ADEQUATE IMMUNIZATIONS AGAINST DIPHTHERIA, TETANUS,
- 6 POLIOMYELITIS, MEASLES (RUBEOLA), GERMAN MEASLES (RUBELLA), AND MUMPS
- 7 IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
- 8 AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
- 9 (C) A STUDENT SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE IMMUNIZATION
- 10 REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IF:
- 11 (1) THE STUDENT SUBMITS TO THE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
- 12 EDUCATION A WRITTEN STATEMENT THAT IMMUNIZATION CONFLICTS WITH THE
- 13 STUDENT'S RELIGIOUS BELIEFS UNLESS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 14 HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE HAS DECLARED AN EMERGENCY OR EPIDEMIC OF
- 15 DISEASE; OR
- 16 (2) THE STUDENT'S LICENSED PHYSICIAN SUBMITS A STATEMENT THAT
- 17 STATES THAT THE ADMINISTRATION OF ONE OR MORE OF THE REQUIRED
- 18 IMMUNIZING AGENTS WOULD BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE STUDENT'S HEALTH.
- 19 (D) EACH INSTITUTION SHALL KEEP THE RECORDS SUBMITTED UNDER
- 20 SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION IN THE FORM AND MANNER REQUIRED
- 21 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
- 22 (E) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, IN
- 23 CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, SHALL
- 24 ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 July 1, 1996.
