A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Local Regulation of Parking - Motorcycles

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a political subdivision, in the exercise of its authority to

- 4 regulate parking, from adopting or enforcing an ordinance or regulation that
- 5 prohibits the parking of more than one motorcycle in a space served by a single
- 6 parking meter.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 9 Section 26-301
- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - Transportation

15 26-301.

16 (a) In this subtitle, "officer" means a police officer or a person other than a police 17 officer who is authorized to issue a citation for a violation of an ordinance or regulation 18 that is adopted under this section.

(b) Any State agency authorized by law and any political subdivision of this State20 may adopt ordinances or regulations that:

21 (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;

(2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of theordinances or regulations;

24 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately25 owned parking lots; and

26 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an27 ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.

(C) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, A
POLITICAL SUBDIVISION MAY NOT ADOPT OR ENFORCE AN ORDINANCE OR
REGULATION THAT PROHIBITS THE PARKING OF MORE THAN ONE MOTORCYCLE
WITHIN A SPACE SERVED BY A SINGLE PARKING METER.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 1996.
