BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 **Article - Transportation** 15 26-301. 16 (a) In this subtitle, "officer" means a police officer or a person other than a police 17 officer who is authorized to issue a citation for a violation of an ordinance or regulation 18 that is adopted under this section. 19 (b) Any SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ANY State agency 20 authorized by law and any political subdivision of this State may adoptordinances or 21 regulations that:

(1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;
