17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (a) The Department shall have a properly equipped public health and clinical  
22 laboratory in each of the following areas:

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1 (1) Annapolis;

2 (2) Cambridge;

4 (4) Easton;
