#### A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# ${\bf 2} \qquad {\bf Natural\ Resources\ -\ Hunting\ License\ Fees\ -\ Nonresidents}$

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the basic hunting license fee for nonresidents of the State
- 4 who reside in certain other states; altering the fee for obtaining individual hunting
- 5 stamps for deer, bow and arrow, black powder, and Maryland migratorywild
- 6 waterfowl for certain nonresidents of the State; providing for a certain effective
- date; and generally relating to the issuance of hunting licenses and tamps to certain
- 8 nonresidents of the State.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 21 **Article - Natural Resources**

- 22 10-301.
- 23 (a) To provide a fund to pay the expense of protecting and managing wildlife, and
- 24 preventing unauthorized persons from hunting them, a person may not hunt or attempt to
- 25 hunt during open season and in any permitted manner any game birds and mammals in
- 26 the State without first having procured either a resident or nonresident hunter's license.
- 27 A person may not hunt or attempt to hunt nongame birds and mammals in Baltimore
- 28 County or Frederick County without first obtaining a license. A permanent resident of a
- 29 government reservation may obtain a resident hunter's license.
- 30 (f) (1) There shall be the following types of hunting licenses in the State:

3 4 5 6 7	(iii) A nonresident basic hunting license that enables thepurchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals during any appropriate season without the purchase of additional stamps unless the purchaser is hunting wild waterfowl or deer during bow and arrow season or black powder season. This license enables the purchaser to hunt wild waterfowl only with the purchase of a Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. This license enables the purchaser to hunt deer during bow and arrow season and black powderseason only with the purchase of the appropriate deer stamp.
11 12 13 14	(iv) A nonresident 3-day hunting license that enables the purchaser to hunt all legal game birds and mammals except deer and turkey for the 3 consecutive legal hunting days in a single season that are specified on the license by the issuing court clerk or agent. The purchaser must also purchase a Maryland migratory wild waterfowl stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp to hunt wild waterfowl with this license. Under no circumstance does this license authorize the purchaser to hunt deer and turkey.
16 17	(4) A nonresident of any age must purchase either a nonresidentbasic hunting license or a nonresident 3-day hunting license to hunt in the State.

29 30	(iv) [Except as provided in subparagraph (v) of this paragraph, nonresident] NONRESIDENT basic\$120.50
33	(v) [Nonresident basic hunting license for residents of Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and West Virginia\$83.00 or a fee equal to the fee charged by the nonresident's home state for asimilar basic hunting license, whichever fee is greater.
