A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Retail Service Station Dealers - Additional Charge Prohibited**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a retail service station dealer from charging a person who
4 purchases motor fuel an additional amount per gallon because the person purchases
5 less than a specified amount of motor fuel.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Business Regulation**

14 10-323.2.

15 A RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER MAY NOT CHARGE A PERSON WHO
16 PURCHASES MOTOR FUEL AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT PER GALLON BECAUSE THE
17 PERSON PURCHASES LESS THAN A SPECIFIED AMOUNT OF MOTOR FUEL.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 1996.
