14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 21	(2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" INCLUDES ANY INDIVIDUAL, EXCEPT AN ELECTED OFFICIAL, WHO IS:

24	(II) A MEMBER OF THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION POLICE

(IV) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS APPOINTED OR GIVEN THE POWERS OF
 A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED AND COMPENSATED BY THE STATE FOR THE
 ENFORCEMENT OF LAW AND THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER ON PROPERTY OF THE
 STATE OR OF ANY OF ITS AGENCIES, OR FOR THE PROTECTION OF SUCH PROPERTY;
 A MEMBER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SECURITY FORCE;

6 (V) A DEPUTY SHERIFF OR ANY OTHER SWORN MEMBER OF A 7 SHERIFF'S OFFICE;

10 (VII) A MEMBER OF THE INVESTIGATIVE SERVICES UNIT OF THE 11 COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE;

12 (VIII) A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK 13 AND PLANNING COMMISSION PARK POLICE; AND

14 (IX) A MEMBER OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY15 POLICE FORCE.

16 (3) "FIRE AND RESCUE WORKER" INCLUDES THOSE INDIVIDUALS
17 DESCRIBED IN § 9-503(A) OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE, WHETHER
18 THE INDIVIDUAL IS PAID OR UNPAID.

19 (B) (1) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS NOT AN OFFICER WITHIN THE20 MEANING OF ARTICLE 35 OF THE MARYLAND DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.

21 (2) A FIRE OR RESCUE WORKER IS NOT AN OFFICER WITHIN THE22 MEANING OF ARTICLE 35 OF THE MARYLAND DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the passage of this Act is
 contingent on the passage of Chapter _____ (S.B. ____/H.B. _____)(6lr1040) of the Acts of
 the General Assembly of 1996, a Constitutional Amendment, and its ratification by the
 voters of the State.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions 28 of Section 2 above, this Act shall take effect December 1, 1996.
