A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Labor and Employment - Reporting of Employment Information**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain employers, within a certain period of time, to
4 submit certain information concerning certain employees to the Secretary of Labor,
5 Licensing, and Regulation and to the Child Support Enforcement Administration.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Labor and Employment**

14 8-626.1.

15 WITHIN 14 DAYS OF AN EMPLOYEE'S BEGINNING EMPLOYMENT, THE
16 EMPLOYEE'S EMPLOYER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY AND TO THE CHILD
17 SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION:

18 (1) THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF THE
19 EMPLOYEE; AND

20 (2) A COPY OF THE EMPLOYEE'S WITHHOLDING ALLOWANCE
21 CERTIFICATE REQUIRED BY THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1996.
