# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### 2 Crimes and Punishments - Cemetery Desecration - Penalties

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum penalties for a person who isconvicted of

- 4 willfully committing certain destructive acts in any cemetery in this State; and
- 5 generally relating to the penalties for committing certain destructive acts in any
- 6 cemetery in this State.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### 14 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

15 267.

(a) Any person who wilfully destroys, mutilates, defaces, injures, or removes any
tomb, monument, gravestone, or other structure placed in any cemetery, or any building,
wall, fence, railing, or other work, for the use, protection, or ornamentation of any
cemetery in this State is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than
[\$2,000,] \$5,000 or imprisoned for not more than [3] 5 years, or both.

(b) Any person who wilfully destroys, cuts, breaks, or removes any tree, plant, or
shrub in any cemetery in this State, or who is found guilty of indecentor disorderly
conduct within said limits, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shallbe fined not more
than [\$500,] \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than [2] 3 years, or both.

(c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the removal of the remains of any human body, or of any monument, gravestone, or other marker from an abandoned cemetery, provided that the prior consent in writing of the State's Attorney of the county or of Baltimore City shall have been secured and provided further that such remains, monuments, gravestone, or other marker is placed in an accessible place in a permanent cemetery.

- 2 October 1, 1996.
