BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 14 15 2-208. 16 (a) There is a Class 7 micro-brewery (on- and off-sale) license. 17 (b) The license shall be issued:

(1) By the State Comptroller;

(2) Only in the following jurisdictions:

(i) Allegany County;

(ii) Baltimore City;

2 1 (iii) Baltimore County; 2 (iv) The City of Annapolis; 3 (v) Anne Arundel County; (vi) The thirteenth election district of Carroll County; 5 (vii) Charles County; 6 (viii) Dorchester County; 7 (ix) Howard County; and 8 (x) Prince George's County; and 9 (3) (I) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) 10 license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in a jurisdiction listed 11 in paragraph (2) of this subsection; AND 12 (II) ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS D ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES 13 LICENSE THAT IS ISSUED FOR USE BY A CLASS D LICENSEE WHOSE BUSINESS IS 14 LOCATED IN THE 22ND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT OF PRINCE GEORGE'S 15 COUNTY. 16 (c) (1) A holder of a Class 7 micro-brewery license: 17 (i) May brew and bottle malt beverages at a single location; and 18 (ii) May not brew more than 10,000 barrels of malt beverage each 19 calendar year. 20 (2) In Allegany County only, the holder of a Class 7 license: 21 (i) May brew in one location and may contract for the bottling of the 22 malt beverage in another location; and 23 (ii) Need not meet the hotel/motel requirements for a Class B beer, 24 wine and liquor licensee but shall meet the requirements for those Class B restaurants. 25 (d) (1) The on-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell at retail beer brewed 26 under this license to customers for consumption on the licensed premises. 27 (2) The off-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell and deliver beer 28 brewed under this license to: 29 (i) Any wholesaler licensed under this article to sell beer in this State; 30 or 31 (ii) Any person who is located in a state other than Maryland who is 32 authorized under the laws of that state to receive brewed beverages. 33 (3) In the City of Annapolis, Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, 34 Baltimore County, Charles County, Howard County, and Prince George's County only,
