- 19 ENGAGING IN CONTACT OR COMMUNICATION:
- 20 (1) IN PERSON OR THROUGH AN AGENT; OR
- 21 (2) THROUGH THE USE OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING MEDIA:
- 22 (I) NEWSPAPER, NEWSLETTER, OR OTHER PRINT MEDIUM;
- 23 (II) POSTAL SERVICE OR OTHER COMMON CARRIER OR
- 24 MESSENGER SERVICE:
- 25 (III) TELEPHONE, WIRE, FACSIMILE, OR OTHER
- 26 TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICE; OR

- 1 (IV) RADIO, TELEVISION, COMPUTER, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC
- 2 DEVICE.
- 3 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY CONTACT OR COMMUNICATE WITH
- 4 A MINOR, WITH KNOWLEDGE OR REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE PERSON IS A
- 5 MINOR, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMMITTING A CRIMINAL ACT AGAINST OR WITH
- 6 THE MINOR.
- 7 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON
- 8 CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000 OR A TERM OF
- 9 IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR BOTH.
