- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from interfering with or obstructing fire and
- 4 emergency services personnel while dispatched on a call for service; and generally

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 13 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 15 (a) It is unlawful for any person willfully to interfere with or obstruct the State
- 16 Fire Marshal, a Deputy State Fire Marshal, Special Assistant State FireMarshal, Special
- 17 Deputy State Fire Marshal, fire fighter, rescue squad member, or emergency services
- 18 personnel, while the State Fire Marshal, Deputy State Fire Marshal, Special Assistant
- 19 State Fire Marshal, Special Deputy State Fire Marshal, fire fighter, rescue squad
- 20 member, or the emergency services personnel is fighting a fire, performing emergency
- 21 service, [or] proceeding to a fire or other emergency, OR WHILE DISPATCHED ON A
- 22 CALL FOR SERVICE.
- 23 (b) It is unlawful for any person willfully to interfere with or obstruct the State
- 24 Fire Marshal, a Deputy State Fire Marshal, Special Assistant State FireMarshal, or

- 1 Special Deputy State Fire Marshal in the course of conducting an inspection or 2 investigating a fire or explosion.
- 3 (c) It is unlawful for any person to:
- 4 (1) Falsely represent himself as being a State Fire Marshal or a sworn 5 employee of the Office of the State Fire Marshal, or a member of any paid or volunteer 6 fire department, rescue squad, or emergency service unit of the State, Baltimore City, or 7 any county or municipal corporation of the State, with fraudulent design on a person or 8 property; or
- 9 (2) Have, use, wear, or display without proper authority, for the purpose of 10 deception, any uniform, shield, button, ornament, identification, or shoulder patch, or any
- 11 simulation or imitation of these articles, adopted by the Office of theState Fire Marshal,
- 12 or by any paid or volunteer fire department, rescue squad, or emergencyservice unit.
- 13 (d) Violation of this section is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not 14 more than three (3) years.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 1996.
