- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to consider certain
- 4 violations of certain laws and regulations when making decisions on whether to
- 5 issue certain licenses or permits or impose conditions on the issuance of certain
- 6 licenses or permits; authorizing the Department of the Environment to deny an
- 7 application for certain permits and licenses under certain conditions; and generally
- 8 relating to permits and licenses issued by the Department.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) WHEN MAKING A DECISION WHETHER TO ISSUE A LICENSE OR PERMIT TO
- 19 A PERSON UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR IMPOSE A CONDITION ON THE ISSUANCE OF A
- 20 LICENSE OR PERMIT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSIDER WHETHER THE
- 21 APPLICANT HAS VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE OR ANY REGULATION
- 22 ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE.

- 1 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DENY AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE OR
- 2 PERMIT UNDER THIS ARTICLE IF THE APPLICANT HAS VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF
- 3 THIS ARTICLE OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN
- 4 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 1996.
