22	(b) The Board of Regents consists of [17] 19 members as follows:

1	(1) One member shall be a full-time student in good academic standing at an institution under the jurisdiction of the Board;
3 4	(2) One member shall be the State Secretary of Agriculture ex officio; [and]
5 6	(3) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBER AT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND COLLEGE PARK; SYSTEM; AND
	(4) ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A FULL TIME FACULTY MEMBER AT AN INSTITUTION UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD OTHER THAN THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND COLLEGE PARK; AND
10 11	[(3)] (5) (4) The remaining members of the Board shall be residents of the State and shall be appointed from the general public.
12 13	(c) In making appointments to the Board, the Governor shall consider representation from all parts of the State.
14 15	(d) Except for the Secretary of Agriculture, each member of the Board shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate.
18	(e) (1) Except for the student member AND THE FACULTY MEMBERS  MEMBER, each appointed member serves for a term of 5 years from July 1 of the year of appointment and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These members may be reappointed.
	(2) The student member shall be appointed for a term of 1 year, from July 1, and may be reappointed if the student remains a student at any campus of the University of Maryland System.
23 24	(3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
	(F) (1) ANY FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBER OF AN INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM MAY BE A CANDIDATE FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD.
	(2) (I) AT EACH INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM, THE FACULTY MEMBERS SHALL DETERMINE A METHOD FOR ELECTION OF A CANDIDATE FOR THE POSITION OF FACULTY MEMBER OF THE BOARD.
