A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Transportation Funding - Grants for Local Paratransit Service

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation to provide annual
- 4 grants to local jurisdictions for paratransit service that complements fixed route
- 5 service in compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act; requiring
- 6 the amount of the grants to be determined in accordance with certainparatransit
- 7 plans and to fully cover the cost of providing paratransit services in compliance with
- 8 the federal Act; and generally relating to grants for local paratransit services.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 **Article Transportation**
- 17 2-103.5.
- 18 (a) Subject to the appropriation requirements and budgetary provisions of §
- 19 3-216 of this article and upon receipt of an approval of a grant application in the form or
- 20 detail that the Secretary reasonably requires, for Fiscal Year [1996] 1997 AND EACH
- 21 FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, the Department shall provide grants for paratransit service
- 22 provided by county or local governments, that is complementary to fixedroute service as
- 23 required under the federal Americans with Disabilities Act.
- 24 (b) The amount of the grants SHALL:
- 25 (1) [Shall be] BE determined in accordance with multiyear paratransit
- 26 plans approved by the Department or the Federal Transit Administration; and
- 27 (2) [May not exceed a total of \$3.45 million statewide in Fiscal Year 1996]
- 28 EQUAL 100% OF THE COST OF PROVIDING PARATRANSIT SERVICES IN COMPLIANCE
- 29 WITH THE FEDERAL AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 1996.
