- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS 19 SECTION.
- 20 (B) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION,
- 21 THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STUDENTS THAT MAY BE ENROLLED IN A CLASS FOR
