AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding § 37-202(a) of the State Personnel and Pensions Article, a State employeewho is a member of a State system may transfer service credit from a local retirement or pension system for a period of employment with a county or municipal corporation if the employee:
5 6	(1) was employed by the State within 60 days after termination of the employment with the county or municipal corporation;
	(2) was not employed by any other employer after termination of employment with the county or municipal corporation and before employment with the State;
