A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Appellate Counsel to the Board of License**  
3 **Commissioners**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City to  
5 employ an attorney to serve as appellate counsel for the Board in actions of appeal;  
6 requiring the Board to set a certain minimum annual salary for appellate counsel;  
7 and generally relating to the powers of the Board of License Commissioners for  
8 Baltimore City.

9 BY adding to

10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
11 Section 15-112(e-2)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 15-112.

18 (E-2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL:

19 (1) EMPLOY A QUALIFIED ATTORNEY TO SERVE AS APPELLATE  
20 COUNSEL FOR THE BOARD IN ACTIONS OF APPEAL; AND

21 (2) SET THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE APPELLATE COUNSEL AT NOT  
22 LESS THAN \$16,000.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 October 1, 1996.
