12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

15 20-206.

16 (f) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A MEMBER OF THE
17 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS A
18 STATE EMPLOYEE.

- 19 (2) Credit for unused sick leave may not be used under this section:
- 20 [(1)] (I) to determine years of eligibility service required for a benefit 21 under this Division II; or
- 22 [(2)] (II) to compute average final compensation.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 July 1, 1996.
