A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **General Assembly - Limitation on Introduction of Bills**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a member of the General Assembly may introduce up
4 to a certain number of bills during a regular or special LegislativeSession; providing
5 for exceptions; and generally relating to the introduction of bills in the General
6 Assembly.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Government**

15 2-1503.1.

16 (A) A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY INTRODUCE UP TO AND
17 INCLUDING NINE BILLS DURING A REGULAR OR SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

18 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO BILLS INTRODUCED ON BEHALF OF A
19 LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY, AN EXECUTIVE
20 DEPARTMENT OR OTHER UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, OR THE OFFICE OF THE
21 GOVERNOR.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 1996.
